The Challenge winner must be nominated to the Breeders' Cup program by the Championship's pre-entry deadline of October 21, 2024 to receive the rewards. #### SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS

Horsemen shipping to Del Mar are reminded of key requirements below for running a horse at the track. Please ensure the following is completed before race-day:

- Lasix/Official Bleeders' Certificate
- California Workers' Compensation
- Current Coggins Test (12 months)
- Foal Certificate Papers
- California Owners' & Trainers' Licenses HISA Vaccination Requirements

Horses receiving lasix are required to arrive at least five hours prior to first post.

#### **SUMMARY OF MEDICATION RULES**

#### NOTICE: CHRB MEDICATION RULE

Horsemen are encouraged to consult with the official vet or equine medical director for any question concerning CHRB medication and vet's list questions. Official veterinarian Dr. Jeff Blea can be reached at (626) 862-6149. The CHRB regulations are compliant with the HISA Anti-Doping and Medication Control Program (ADMC).

**BLEEDERS**: California requires race day furosemide (Lasix) to be administered by 3rd party veterinary professionals. Trainers with questions should contact Dr. Michael Pirrone (575) 312-9684. Horses must be registered as a bleeder with the official veterinarian at time of entry to be eligible to receive Lasix on race day. Lasix is the only authorized bleeder medication in California. Treatment with lasix is permitted 4 hours prior to post time with a minimum dose of 3 cc and a maximum dose of 5 cc. Lasix treatment is not permitted for two-year-old races or any stakes races.

**SHOCK WAVE THERAPY**: All SWT machines are to be registered with the CHRB Official Veterinarian and stored at the equine hospital. The use of SWT machines is limited to veterinarians only. Horses that have had a SWT treatment shall not race for thirty days following a treatment. All SWT treatments are to be reported to the CHRB Official Veterinarian on a separate confidential sheet. Any SWT that is not performed within the designated area by the Equine Hospital will result in the confiscation of the machine. Confiscated machines will not be returned until after the close of the meet.

#### **AFTER RACING EQUINE POLICY**

Any owner or trainer who directly or indirectly participates in the transport of a horse from Del Mar to either a slaughterhouse or an auction house engaged in selling horses for slaughter, shall be prohibited from any allotment or use of a stall or stalls at Del Mar, or other off-track stabling facility over which Del Mar exercises any control or indirectly funds.

#### **RACING INCENTIVES**

DMTC reserves the right to determine eligibility for qualified starters.

#### SHIP & WIN

Out of state horses are eligible to participate in Del Mar's substantial summer Ship & Win incentives aimed to both increase runner & horse population in California.

- \$4,000 Starter Bonus for FIRST START.
- 40% Purse Bonus for EVERY START of the summer meet

Start a horse at Del Mar this summer, who last ran out of state, to take advantage of the program. Horse must not have raced in California in the last 12 months, and their previous start must have been made outside of California. Horses stabled in California that travel out of state to make a qualifying start are not eligible. First-time starters do not qualify.

Purse bonuses apply to earnings for placings 1-5 and exclude stakes races. Ship & Win starter bonus includes stakes races. If a S&W horse is acquired after its initial start, the original owner will receive purse bonuses from subsequent starts.

Purse bonuses will extend to a horse which makes its initial S&W start in May or June at Santa Anita. Further, that same horse may make up to two starts during that period and still have its purse benefits extended through the Del Mar summer meet.

#### MAIDEN DIRT BONUS

Del Mar is offering a 20% purse bonus to horses, of any age, in the following maiden races on the dirt:

- Maiden Special Weight Dirt Races
- Maiden Special Weight Cal-Bred Dirt Races

Purse bonus will be awarded directly to ownership and applies to earnings for placings 1-5 in open races and 2-5 in Cal-Bred races.

Trainers must have fewer than 85 horses on the Southern California Circuit to qualify for program. Horses may not dual-qualify for Ship & Win.





#### TRACK OPERATIONS

#### **MAIN TRACK**

The Track will be open between the hours of 4:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. There will be three renovation breaks at 6:00 a.m., 7:15 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Horses galloping on the track at less than a two-minute clip will be required to stay 25 feet from the inside rail. No backtracking the first 15 minutes after each break. The first 10 minutes after the first two breaks will be reserved for workers only of 3/8's or more. The Training Track will be open from 5:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. with two renovation breaks at 6:45 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. No pony training allowed during the first ten minutes after the break. Use of riding crop during morning hours is for safety purposes only, no striking allowed.

#### **TURF COURSE**

Turf works will take place from 9:45 - 10:15 a.m. on Thursdays and Sundays, the first day of turf works will take place on Wednesday, July 17. No turf works on Thursday, July 18. Only those horses preparing for specific races will be allowed on the course. Maidens are not permitted to work on the turf. Permission must be obtained from the Racing Secretary. Ponies will not be permitted on the Turf Course (unless approved by the Racing Secretary). Trainers must request turf works at least one day in advance. Del Mar reserves the right to limit the number of turf works to 30 in order to preserve the surface and ensure safety.

#### **SHOE POLICY FOR TURF COURSE & MAIN TRACK**

- HORSES RUNNING WITHOUT SHOES: Trainers who choose to run their horse without shoes (no shoes, only shoes in front, or only shoes behind) on either the TURF or DIRT surface must declaire this intention at the time of entry.
- Silver Queens are not permitted on the Turf Course.

#### **ATTENTION HORSEMEN**

- Horsemen are reminded of the extreme danger posed to horses and riders from
  improperly secured exercise bandages. Please be certain that all bandages are properly
  secured through the use of SAFETY PINS and/or ELECTRICAL/DUCT TAPE. NO MASKING
  TAPE or other light—weight tape should be used at any time. No polo bandages for
  official timed workouts.
- BY ORDER OF STEWARDS: Cushion whips are required for morning training. No buggy whips allowed by rule 1685. No cell phone usage on track during training.
- BY ORDER OF STEWARDS: When lights and horns are activated, riders are required to
  pull up to a jog allowing outriders to aid the horse(s) and rider(s) involved and safely
  have ambulance(s) access the track. Failure to follow will result in immediate violation.

#### ENTRIES

- Entries close at such time when all entries have been taken, unless otherwise specified in the conditions for a sweepstakes.
- Horses on the also-eligible list are not "in today" horses. Such horses may enter for the
  succeeding day and receive any preference to which they may be entitled; however if a
  horse gets in a succeeding race it will be scratched automatically from the race to which
  he was also eligible. Stakes races excluded. The status of such horses should be noted
  at the time of entry.
- In all allowance/claiming races, allowance horses are preferred.
- The racing secretary may refuse the entry of a horse at any time.
- Horses that have started for \$6,250 or less in their last five starts are ineligible to run in races at five furlongs on the turf, unless approved by the racing office.
- No entry will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and
  objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions
  of any race shall be decided by the Stewards, and their decision upon all matters shall
  be final.

A valid 2024 Del Mar Agreement must be signed by both Trainer and Attending Veterinarian and provided to Del Mar prior to acceptance of any entry.

#### **SCRATCHES**

- Scratch time will be 10:00 a.m. two days prior to the races.
- The deadline for scratches from stakes races will be no later than <u>one hour before post</u>
   <u>time</u> the day of the race. As a courtesy to the public, the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club
   requests that trainers wishing to scratch from a stakes race do so prior to the third race.
- In <u>all overnight races</u> with more than ten interests, trainers may declare out to that number by the specified scratch time, such practice to be determined by lot if necessary.
   Scratches below ten may be made only by permission of the Stewards.
- Pursuant to CHRB Rules 1602 and 1629 only the Stewards may declare a horse out of any overnight race after the scratch time designated for the race.
- The Stewards reserve the right to withdraw or scratch any horse which, in their opinion, will not qualify for the race in which it has been entered.
- No horse shall be permitted to start that has not been fully identified.
- Registration papers of every horse entered must be on file in the Racing Office before scratch time unless otherwise approved by the Stewards.

#### ATTENTION HORSEMEN

- The Thoroughbred Owners of California has directed DMTC to make a per start fee deduction in the amount of \$158 from each owner's paymaster account for the purpose of funding the 2024 worker's compensation insurance program for California jockeys administered by Post Time Self Insurance Group. Any owner who desires to opt-out from having such deduction made from their account must notify Post Time directly at info@ sigsolutions.com or Post Time Self Insurance Group, 4961 Katella Ave., Los Alamitos, CA 90720. Questions should be directed to Post Time Self Insurance Group.
- Any horse drawn into the body of the race because of inaccurate information could be scratched and such horse could lose its previously held date.
- As per rule 1865A the alteration or change of sex of horses will be strictly enforced.
   Forms will be available to insure proper notification.
- Equine Microchip: All trainers are required to notify the Horse Identification Office of all un-microchipped horses as they arrive on the grounds.
- Trainers and owners will be permitted to enter up to three (3) horses in any Maiden Special race, however not to the exclusion of another unassociated horse, and, further, provided there are at least seven wagering interests in the race.
- In all two-year-old maiden races there will be no more than ten horses carded in the body of the race.
- In all overnight races, excluding maiden races, winners will be preferred unless otherwise stated in the conditions of the race.
- In handicaps, preference will be given based on the weight assigned, adjusted for scale and sex allowance, regardless of joint ownership.
- In races that overfill, trainers must declare preference of runners with identical ownership at time of entry. Same owner second choice horses will be least preferred. There will be no coupled entries in any race.
- In allowance stakes, preference will be given based on high weights according to allowances adjusted for scale and sex allowance, regardless of joint ownership. Unless otherwise noted in allowance stakes races, preference of horses with equal weights will be determined by 2024 non-claiming earnings.
- In maiden special races, horses that have finished 2nd, 3rd or 4th in a maiden special race since starting for \$40,000 or less, will not be subject to the maiden special preference clause.
- If the management considers it inadvisable for any reason to run a scheduled turf race on the turf course, it will be run at a corresponding distance on the main track.
- The clause "Races when entered for...not considered" applies to both eligibility and allowances unless otherwise qualified.
- ELIGIBILITY AND ALLOWANCES: "Closed races" are considered as those restricted to
   "Non-Winners of three races of \$21,000 other than Maiden Claiming or Starter" or
   less. (Non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming, etc.). For purposes of
   determining eligibility in closed races, a win in any group race in Part I or II countries,
   regardless of purse value, shall be considered a win at or above the qualifying amount
   of \$21,000.

- A horse which wins conditioned allowance races restricted to state breds, or state bred stakes will remain eligible for the open once other than allowance race, provided that horse does not win an open stakes race or allowance race following that start.
- Winners of a Cal-Bred first conditioned allowance dirt race will be eligible to run in the same condition on turf. Winners of a Cal-Bred first conditioned allowance turf race will be eligible to run in the same condition on dirt.
- California Bred supplemental purse monies earned in qualifying open races will be disregarded for eligibility purposes.
- Starter races will not be considered as claiming races in regards to preference clauses.
   Starter race earnings will be included in stakes preference earnings. For weight allowance purposes, starter races will be considered as claiming races.
- Horses penalized in a race shall not be entitled to any of the allowances in such a race.
   Horses not entitled to the first allowance in a race are not entitled to the second and if not the second, then to any subsequent allowance unless specified in the conditions of the race.
- Owners and trainers when entering horses in races are cautioned to check carefully the
  eligibility of their horse and the allowances claimed in all races. Under the universal
  rules of racing an owner or trainer is responsible for the eligibility and the weight the
  horse carries. The Racing Secretary will be glad to give horsemen any information in
  respect to their horses that is desired, but the final responsibilities rest with the owners
  and trainers.
- The Jockey Club registration certificates including digital formats of all horses on the overnight must be on file in the racing office by scratch time. Failure to do so may result in declaration per CHRB rule 1588.
- Retroactive purse changes and bonus payments will not be considered for eligibility, allowances or in any computation of earnings. Earnings as reported in Equibase will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility, allowances and preference.
- Horses without a jockey named at entry time will have an alternate rider named by the Racing Office. Said horses must have a secured jockey by scratch time.
- Trainers must have an apprentice engaged before claiming an apprentice allowance.
- A rider may be named on two horses in a race provided one is on the also-eligible list.
- Any jockey taken off mounts due to illness is not eligible to be named on horses until approved by the Track Physician or the Stewards.

#### **VET LIST**

Unsoundness requiring a Veterinarian Scratch from a race or being observed unsound post-race.

• A horse placed on the Veterinarian's List as unsound shall stay on the Veterinarian's List for a minimum of 14 days. The horse shall be required to work five-eighths of a mile in an official time of 1:03 or better and demonstrate racing soundness to the official of Racing Veterinarian. A post-work blood and/or urine sample shall be taken from the horse and the laboratory findings shall apply to such official workout in the same manner as to a scheduled race. The horse shall not be removed from the Veterinarian's List until all tests have cleared. Contact the CHRB Official Veterinarian for any questions.

Illness Requiring a Veterinarian Scratch

- Horses on the Veterinarian's List as sick shall stay on the Veterinarian's List for a minimum of 7 days. Horses cannot be entered while still on the Veterinarian's List.
- Injury Requiring a Veterinarian Scratch
- Horses on the Veterinarian's List as injured shall stay on the Veterinarian's List for a minimum of 10 days.
- Horses on the veterinarians list in other states are ineligible to enter without approval by the Board of Stewards within limitations of CHRB Rule 1588(j).

ALL WORKS FOR REMOVAL FROM THE VETERINARIAN'S LIST SHALL BE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.

# RULES OF ELIGIBILITY FOR HORSES RACING AT DEL MAR

The Rules of Racing adopted by the California Horse Racing Board govern all races under the auspices of the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club.

For three-year-olds and up which have broken their maiden:

- Any horse which has started for less than \$4,000 must finish first, second or third for \$4,000 or more since.
- A maiden which has started in a maiden race for less than \$12,500 will not be eligible, unless, after such start, that horse finishes 2nd, 3rd or 4th in a race for \$12,500 or greater.
- 3. Maidens over six-years-old are not eligible and will not be allowed to stable at Del Mar or any approved training facility.

Once a horse has started at Del Mar, it may not lose its eligibility during the meeting. However, any eligible horse which leaves during the meeting and races elsewhere must again satisfy the original eligibility requirements before being approved to return.

ELIGIBILITY DOES NOT IMPLY AUTOMATIC APPROVAL. It means consideration on the basis of performance and potential in our racing program.

Horses over 10 years of age are ineligible to be stabled or race at Del Mar.

#### **DATE PREFERENCE SYSTEM**

- Any horse that has started prior to July 20 will receive a "zero date" regardless if papers are on file. Foal papers are still required to be submitted to racing office, but are irrelevant for date system purposes.
- 2. First-time starters will receive a zero date regardless if foal papers are on file. Foal papers are still required to be submitted to racing office at entry time.
- 3. For horses that run elsewhere after July 20 will receive the corresponding date of the day they run, regardless if papers are on file.
- 4. Preference dates will not supersede conditions of a race.
- 5. Any horse that is scratched from a race transferred from the turf to the dirt will retain its previous date.
- 6. A zero date takes preference over a running date.
- 7. Horses that run will receive a running date corresponding to the date they race and lose the date previously held.
- Horses which are scratched will keep their date for the day of the race from which they scratched.
- 9. Any horse running in a stakes race at Del Mar will retain its previously held preference date.
- 10. Preference dates are good at any distance and for any category, with the exception of rule #4.
- 11. All horses placed on the Stewards, Veterinarians or Starters lists will not be permitted to enter until they have been approved to start. Horses placed on these lists will keep their dates if they ran in the particular race in which they made the list. Horses which are scratched, or placed on the Vet's list as injured or unsound, will be given a date for the day the horse comes off the list.
- 12. In no way does the claiming, ownership transfer or trainer transfer of a horse affect the preference date.
- 13. Any horse that is excluded from an overfilled turf race at Santa Anita in June will receive a super date for the identical race from which they were excluded, provided it was determined that horse was in good standing at entry time. This does not include horses who were excluded due to being entered for claiming price.
- 14. In overfilled races, trainers must declare a first and second choice with horses having identical ownership. In all races except for stakes, regardless of all conditions, same owner second will be last.
- 15. Horses in "good standing" which are excluded from a race due to oversubscibed entries and run subsequently in an "extra race", of the same conditions and distance as the originally scheduled race, shall receive the date from the originally scheduled race when entering back in the same condition.

Any horse on the "also eligible" that is declared will retain its original date providing there are no scratches in the body of the race by scratch time.

#### **WORKOUT CRITERIA**

The following are the workout criteria that will be in effect for the 2024 Meet. The minimum official, recorded workout distances and number of works for horses to run at the 2024 Meet are as follows:

- For distances up to 5 1/2 furlongs: all first time starters must have three works, one at least 1/2 mile. For distances 6 furlongs or more: all first time starters must have three works, one at least 5/8 mile.
- 2. Horses which have not raced in <u>90 days</u>: three works, one of which shall be at least 5/8 mile, two works during the last 60 days, and one work during the last 30 days. In races less than six furlongs: three works, two of at least 1/2 mile, two works during the last 60 days and one work during the last 30 days.
- 3. Horses which have not raced in 60 days: two works, with one during the last 30 days.
- 4. Horses which have not raced in 30 days: one work at least 3/8 mile within those 30 days.
- Imported Horses: The workout requirement will be waived for horses entering within 14
  days of clearing U.S.D.A. quarantine, provided that the country of origin's racing jurisdiction
  has no provision for timed workouts.
- All horses which meet the workout criteria may be entered and race. Horsemen seeking to run a horse not meeting the workout criteria must obtain the permission of the Stewards. ALL HORSES THAT ARE ENTERED TO RACE MUST MEET THE WORKOUT REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO ENTRY.
- Horses eased or placed on Stewards' list for poor performance or beaten over 30 lengths
  in last start without cause will be required to show a 5/8 mile work prior to next race.
  Exceptions: Two-year-olds running less than 5/8 mile, who will be required to work race
  distance.
- Any horse 4YO or older that has not raced MUST work 5 furlongs in 1:03 or better for an official California regulatory veterinarian and must have blood drawn. Horses must race within 30 days of all official workout criteria being met.
- 9. Horses off for 120 days or more, but less than one year. Days off are counted from the date of the horse's last race to the date of the race the horse is being entered for (i.e. race date-to-race date). Horses must have a vet exam within 14 days of entry time.
- 10. Horses which have not raced in a year or longer, must work for official veterinarian in 1:03 or better and have blood drawn. Horses must race within 30 days of all official workout criteria being met.
- 11. Requests for workout corrections may only be made within 24 hours. Check the work tab and call the clockers and stewards if changes are necessary.



To assist owners & trainers with placement of their retired racehorses

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- 1. Owners of the horse must participate in the 0.03% (3/10 ths of 1%) purse contribution program adopted by the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB).
- 2. The horse must have raced or have a recorded work at a CHRB recognized track or training center in the last six months (Santa Anita Park, Los Alamitos, Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, Golden Gate Fields, San Luis Rey Downs or CARF).
- 3. The horse must be a gelding, filly or mare. Intact males **must** be gelded prior to acceptance.

# CALIFORNIA BRED OR SIRED MAIDEN BONUS PROGRAM ALONG WITH ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR CALIFORNIA BREDS

This Program will provide: a \$15,000 bonus made available for owners of registered California Bred or Sired maidens in Maiden Special races in Southern California.

The bonus will go to the owner of the winner and will be paid directly by the CTBA.

If a California Bred wins an open Maiden Special race, the owner would also receive the current owner bonus available in open company as well as the \$15,000.

- CALIFORNIA-BRED RACES. All California-Bred races will read "for California Bred or California Sired." A "California Sired" horse is a thoroughbred that was conceived in California by a registered California stallion. A California-sired horse is only eligible for entry in races restricted to California-bred or California-sired horses and is not eligible for any breeders or owners awards.
- In California Bred allowance races, horses that are entered for the claiming price are running for a purse of \$43,000.

# CALIFORNIA BRED OR SIRED ELIGIBILTY ADVANTAGES TO WINNERS:

#### TWO-YEAR-OLDS

 State-bred wins shall not be considered for eligibility purposes in open allowance races for Two-Year -Olds. This shall include wins in any State-bred Two-Year -Old stakes. State-bred first condition allowance races may have an optional claiming price of \$80,000.

#### THREE-YEAR-OLDS

- State-bred wins shall not be considered for eligibility purposes in open allowance races for Three-Year-Olds. This shall include wins in any State-bred stakes. State-bred first condition allowance races may have an optional claiming price of \$80,000.
- All wins in STATE-BRED age restricted stakes for TWO- YEAR-OLDS & THREE- YEAR-OLDS will not be considered in lifetime eligibility or open allowance races.

#### THREE-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD, FOUR-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD

- In all TWO other than open allowance races and above, all State-bred wins (including stakes) will not be considered for eligibility purposes.
- FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD which have not won \$10,000 TWO times other than MAIDEN, CLAIMING, STARTER OR STATE-BRED, or which have never won THREE RACES...
- Once a STATE BRED horse wins the open TWO other than allowance condition, they may not win this condition again, unless eligible for the 'never won THREE races'... part of the condition OR is in for the stipulated CLAIMING PRICE...
- A State-bred horse which has broken its maiden cannot win an open first allowance race twice in Southern California.

#### CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD OFFICE

- HOURS. The California Horse Racing Board Office is open on Wednesday through Sunday 7 AM - 5 PM (ext. 3885). Licenses may be applied for and renewed or validated. Full information on workmen's compensation is also available at this office.
- Trainers are requested to check and amend their list of stable help in order that their 2024 license cards may be approved by the California Horse Racing Board.
- INSURANCE. The California Horse Racing Board requires a signed written binder of Worker's Compensation or a Certificate of Insurance verifying proper coverage be in their file before a trainer's license can be issued or a horse permitted to start.
- Horsemen shipping from out of state are advised to bring such Worker's Compensation document for filing with the Board. Out-of-state insurance must state: COVERS ALL RACING OPERATIONS IN CALIFORNIA.

#### STABLE AREA

**POST TIME**. A Klaxon will sound in the Stable Area in order to notify trainers and grooms that their horses should leave the Stable Area for the receiving barn approximately 20 minutes prior to the receiving barn scheduled time.

**STALL MAINTENANCE**. In the event electrical equipment in your stalls is not working, please notify the stable office (858) 794-1081. During the meeting, the Stable Superintendent should be notified at least 36 hours in advance in the event of maintenance needs in any stalls.

**PERSONNEL ADMISSION INTO STABLE AREA.** The California Horse Racing Board and the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club have jurisdiction over the entrance of any and all personnel into the grounds.

Admittance to the Stable Area is restricted to owners, their guests, trainers and their employees, racing officials and the working press upon presentation of proper credentials.

No visitors are permitted without authorized passes issued by the Stable Gate Office.

**STABLE AREA PARKING**. Parking and storing of automobiles under barn roofs, between barns or in posted areas is strictly prohibited at any time except with special permission. The dismantling or repairing of any motor vehicle is prohibited in the stable area. Speed limit in the stable area—5 miles per hour.

In order that the maximum protection may be afforded horses and employees during training hours in the stable area, the management of Del Mar is in full accord with Trainers and Horsemen in that the use and parking of automobiles in this area is restricted during training hours.

To offset any congestion of automobiles in and around the stable area designated parking area for Owners, Trainers and Stable employees will be provided.

All parking rules and regulations will be strictly enforced.

**DOGS**. Del Mar has no desire to deprive horsemen of the pleasure and aid provided by dogs, BUT loose dogs are a menace and can not be tolerated. All dogs must be registered at the Stable Office showing breed, age, sex, license number and owner. As provided for in the County Ordinance all dogs will be required to be under leash at all times. Dogs are required to be licensed and wear Stable Area tags. Stray dogs picked up during training hours will be barred from the premises.

#### **CLAIMING PROCEDURES**

Any thoroughbred claimed may not race out of state until the conclusion of the meet or 45 days, whichever is longer, without approval of the Racing Secretary. **Failure to comply may result in the loss of stabling privileges**.

**SALES TAX**. The sales tax that must be paid when claiming is 8.75%.

**MAY A CLAIMANT TRANSFER A HORSE HE HAS CLAIMED?** A successful claimant may not transfer or sell a horse he has claimed (for racing purposes) for a period of 30 days. The racing association may demand that the horse be removed from the grounds and the association is not obligated to provide such horse stall space on the grounds.

**TRANSFER OF HORSES ON THE GROUNDS**. The purchase or claim or transfer of any horse on the grounds at Del Mar, whether by private sale, claiming, or public auction DOES NOT GUARANTEE THE NEW OWNER A STALL FOR SUCH HORSE. The management of Del Mar Thoroughbred Club reserves the right to allocate stalls.

Horses claimed or sold to any person or stable not registered for racing at Del Mar must be removed from the grounds within 24 hours, unless permission to remain is given by Del Mar Thoroughbred Club.

**1663. ENTRY OF CLAIMED HORSE.** A horse claimed out of a claiming race shall be eligible to race at any racing association within the State of California immediately after being claimed. Claimed horses that do not win races in which they were claimed will be eligible to race within 25 days at the same level. Claimed winners will still be required to run for at least a 25% increase during the 25-day period. A claimed horse may be removed from the grounds of the association where it was claimed for non-racing purposes.

#### **HISA RULE 2262 - WAIVER CLAIMING OPTION**

At time of entry into a Claiming Race an Owner or Trainer may opt to declare a Horse ineligible to be claimed provided:

- a. Horse has not started in 120 days;
- b. Horse's last start must have been for a claiming price; and
- c. Horse is entered for a claiming price equal or greater than the price it last started for.

#### **RIDING CROP POLICY**

- Riders may not use the crop more than six times during a race, excluding showing or waiving the crop or tapping the horse on the shoulder.
- Riders may not use the crop more than two times in succession (within the six-time limit) without giving the horse a chance to respond before using the crop again.
- The crop must be used in an underhanded position with the crop always at or below the shoulder level of the jockey.
- During training, the crop may only be used for the safety of horse or rider.
- Absent mitigating circumstances, which includes but is not limited to use of the riding
  crop for the safety of horse and rider, if a jockey or exercise rider rides in a manner
  contrary to this rule, the stewards shall impose a maximum fine of \$1,000 and a
  minimum suspension of three days. In trial heats, the suspension shall include the
  subsequent related stakes race.
- The jockey or exercise rider shall not be penalized if, in the opinion of the stewards, the use of the crop was necessary for the safety of the horse or rider.

#### FIRE PREVENTION RULES

The following fire prevention rules and regulations pertaining to horsemen and the Del Mar Stable area will be in effect during the 2024 Del Mar Thoroughbred Club meeting.

- In case of fire, call DMTC Security Dispatch at (858) 792 4350 for immediate assistance.
- Regardless of size of fire, turn in an alarm. When stabling, locate nearest alarm box assigned your stable. Also note location of fire extinguisher and hose in your barn.
- Positively no smoking is allowed in horse stalls, feed rooms or other hazardous places.
   Striking or lighting of matches in stalls or feed rooms is also prohibited.
- If any fire equipment in your area is used or damaged please report it at once to the Stable Superintendent, or to any uniformed security guard, or report directly to the Fire Station located just south of the Receiving Barn on the track grounds.
- Do not connect any electrical appliance to lighting circuits at any time. Use convenience
  outlets on walls only for this purpose. Do not connect any two electrical appliances
  of 1000 watts or greater to any one convenience outlet circuit at any one time. Open
  flames, including candles, are not allowed. If in doubt, contact stable superintendent.
- Do not sleep in feed rooms. This is prohibited at all times.
- Cigar and cigarette stubs: Have a metal container partly filled with water to dispose of same in each tack room or where needed. Make certain that matches and cigarettes are extinguished.
- No parking of vehicles in front of fire equipment, barn runyards, gates, or barrier entrance to barns is allowed.
- Fire hose boxes and fire hydrants must remain in the clear, and the hose is to be used for fire only
- All types of rubbish containers must remain outside of barns away from underneath the barn roofs.
- No plastic or rubber containers may be used when cooking and or heating grain. All
  containers must be fire resistant and melt proof.
- All electrical appliances must be in safe working condition. If they are not, report the
  appliance to the security officers or to the stable superintendent.
- Do not face electrical heaters or devices too close to walls, bedding, clothing or any material or flammable nature.
- Use of flammable liquids in the barn area for spraying, cleaning, etc., is prohibited.
- Any type of DDT spraying fluid with an oil base or other oil-based liquid used for spraying the barn area must be approved by fire personnel.
- No open fires are permitted at any time.
- Do not tie horses or dogs to gate barriers or guard rails around fire hydrants. This also applies to fire hose boxes and extinguishers at the barns.
- All horses must have halters on when they are in their stalls.
- The halter shank is to be placed in the immediate vicinity of each horse.
- You are not permitted to place a lock of any type on stall doors of horses.
- All approved pens must be placed in middle of shed rows and must not block shed rows or roadways.

#### **SAFETY**

- HISA RULES & REGULATIONS. All participants must comply with current HISA regulations <u>hisaus.org/regulations</u>. Including but not limited to:
  - Safety Helmets & Vests
  - Riding Crops
  - Horseshoes
  - Claiming Rules
  - Veterinarian's List



- CELLPHONE USAGE. The use of cellphones while mounted on a racehorse is
  prohibited at all times. Cellphones may only be used on a lead pony while stationary and
  unattached to a racehorse. This includes, but is not limited to, air pods and Bluetooth
  devices.
- TATTOOING OF HORSES. All trainers are required to notify the Horse Identification Office of all un-tattooed horses as they arrive on the grounds.
- PADDOCK SCHOOLING. Appointments for schoolers will be taken in person, or by
  calling the paddock judge at 858-792-4341 at 8:00 a.m. day of race. A total of 14 horses
  are allowed in the paddock at one time. Stakes horses and "In Today" horses have first
  preference, all others will be given spots as they become available. Trainers are strictly
  limited to 5 spots per day. NO AFTERNOON SCHOOLING ON OPENING DAY, PACIFIC
  CLASSIC DAY OR CLOSING DAY.
- GROOMS' ATTIRE. All grooms should be neatly dressed when taking horses to the
  paddock. Pony riders taking horses to the post in the public parade must wear jackets
  available at the receiving barn and must keep themselves and their mounts well
  groomed and their tack clean.
- REGISTRATION OF HORSES. Attention Owners & Trainers!: In compliance with a
  directive from the California Horse Racing Board, foal certificates must have the proper
  ownership displayed on the back in order to be eligible for registration and racing.
- After horses have been registered with the Racing Secretary, listing their owners, no horse will be transferred (unless claimed at this meeting) without permission of the Stewards who will require a notarized bill of sale from the registered owner.

• The Paymaster of Purses Office is open from 10:00 a.m. until the start of the last race on racing days to transact business with horsemen.

- PAYMENT OF PURSE MONEY. Standard hold on Purses is 48 hours. No purse money
  will be released from any Horseman's account that does not have a current signed
  and dated tax form on file in the Paymaster's office. (W-8ECI or W-9 accordingly).
  Partnership accounts will require only one tax ID from the managing partner.
- FEES. All Nomination, Entry, and Start fees for Stakes as well as all Jockey fees are required to be deposited in the Paymaster's office before the horse starts in a race.
- CLAIMING TAX. 2024 claim tax rate in Del Mar is 8.75%
- WIRING INSTRUCTIONS. Licensed horsemen may fund their accounts with a wire transfer using the following instructions.

Be certain to include the BENEFICIARY ACCOUNT NAME and NUMBER that the wired money is to be deposited into in the Paymasters office.

# DEL MAR THOROUGHBRED CLUB CONSERVATION PROGRAM

Conservation is an important aspect of our daily living here in California. As we approach the live meet we would like to remind trainers, owners and backside employees that we have a responsibility to conserve our natural resources and ensure that hazardous materials do not enter our water systems.

The Del Mar Thoroughbred Club realizes the importance of water conservation and has developed a program that will work to reduce water consumption and eliminate the disposal of waste or hazardous material into the drains, during the live meet. DMTC staff will work in conjunction with the California Thoroughbred Trainers to ensure the success of this program.

Conserving electricity is another area of concentration for the meet. We ask that when lights are not necessary for the safety of your employees and horses that they be turned off.

Water Conservation signs, in both English and Spanish will be posted throughout the backside prior to the first horses arriving at the track. Risk Management staff and DMTC Security staff will work with violators to ensure they understand the requirements of the program and assist them in becoming compliant.

Security will be in the stable area 7 days a week to ensure compliance of the Water Conservation Program as well as electrical conservation.

Following are the rules and stipulated fines for the Water Conservation Program. Should you have any questions please feel free to call the Risk Management Department at 858-792-4233.

#### Barns that fail to follow the rules will be reported to CHRB stewards.

We thank you for your cooperation.

Following are the rules, enforcement responsibilities and the stipulated fines and actions that will be in place during the live meet.

#### **RULES**

- NEW Runoff from washing machines must drain into the sewer and not a down spout or the ground. Please contact Stable Office for assistance.
- All hoses MUST have shut off valves and/or nozzles. (no cut off hoses)
- Hoses may not be placed in the drains.
- Running water MUST be turned off between uses.
- No waste or hazardous material may be washed down drains.
- Hoses without shut off valves/nozzles or found in drains may be confiscated.
- All washers must be turned off at the source when not in use.
- Unnecessary lights must be turned off during daylight hours
- No vehicles in wash racks or washing of personal vehicles on grounds.
- Violation of rules will result in fines/citation(s) and disciplinary action.

#### **ENFORCEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

The DMTC Security and DMTC Risk Management Department will be responsible for enforcement of this program.

- DMTC Security, while on normal patrols, will ensure that each barn is in compliance with the Water Conservation Program. If a violation has occurred a citation will be issued.
- DMTC Security and Risk Management Department will work with the trainers, grooms and hot walkers to ensure they have an understanding of the water conservation program and are in compliance. Citations will be issued when necessary.
- Other DMTC staff having access to the backside will report any violations to DMTC Security or Risk Management.

#### **Stipulated Fines/Action**

The following fines and actions will be taken for violations to the Water Conservation Policy Rules: (Water Officer and/or Stable Security will issue all citations)

First Offense \$50.00 fine payable to DMTC

Second Offense Reported to CHRB Stewards with copy of first Offense.

#### CALIFORNIA RETIREMENT MANAGEMENT ACCOUNT

California Retirement Management Account (CARMA) is a non-profit, charitable organization created to raise money for retired California racehorses. It is run by an independent board of directors, the organization hosts fundraising events, educates owners and trainers on equine retirement, raises awareness, and works to unify the industry in support of our equine athletes.

CARMA worked with the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) to adopt a rule change allowing for a 0.3% deduction from purses to help fund equine retirement. This deduction is used to help support farms and other non-profit programs that care for and retrain retired Thoroughbred racehorses. Owners can obtain opt-out forms at any of the paymaster offices in California or at www.chrb.ca.gov.

CARMA manages a grant request process and disburses funds to qualified retirement facilities caring for, retraining and adopting Thoroughbred racehorses. CARMA is dedicated to the goal of providing funding for the rehabilitation, retraining and/or retirement of Thoroughbred horses that have raced in California. It is only through the cooperation and assistance of the entire industry that this can be accomplished.


#### **POLICY ON GAMBLING**


